My clinical interests are paediatric otolaryngology and otology. I am the surgeon for the Oxford Cochlear Implant Programme which implants about 70 children and adults per annum, including simultaneous bilateral cochlear implantation and hearing preservation cochlear implantation. I also am co-director of the Oxford Bone Anchored Hearing Aid Programme. I also perform other ear surgery as well as providing specialised paediatric surgery including airway surgery.

I am involved in research in cochlear implantation and otitis media in childhood. I am the Director of Teaching for the otolaryngology undergraduate curriculum in the Oxford University Medical School. I am on the regional training committee for the Oxford School for surgery. I regularly examine on regional & national exam preparation courses.
